install guide · v1.0 · setup takes about 60 seconds

Load your expert into your AI

step: 1

Download your skill file

Sign in to your dashboard at skilset.io/dashboard and download the version for your AI.
Claude users: grab the Claude.ai upload version (or Claude Code version if you use the terminal).
ChatGPT and Gemini versions are listed alongside it.

step: 2

Load it — Claude.ai

1. Open claude.ai and create a new Project (left sidebar > Projects > New).
2. Inside the project, click "Add content" under Project knowledge.
3. Upload your skill file. Done — every chat in that project now has the skill loaded.

step: 2

Load it — Claude Code

1. Place the file in your skills folder (e.g. `~/claude/skills/` or your project skills directory).
2. Start Claude Code in that project. The skill loads automatically.

step: 2

Load it — ChatGPT / Gemini

Attach the skill file at the start of a conversation, or add it to a ChatGPT Project / Gemini Gem for permanent loading. Same file, same trigger.

step: 3

Ask like you would ask them

Type the trigger and your question: `@ChrisFix` my brakes are grinding. What do I check first?
Natural phrasing works too — "hey ChrisFix" or just the first name.
Skills with multiple areas route your question to the right expertise automatically.
You can also upload a photo of your situation and the skill will apply the creator's checks to it.
